### Document Description:

When you specify the user ID and password on the RUNRMTCMD command that's used to initiate a job on a PC or NT server from an AS/400, you must enclose both the user name and password in single quotation marks.

In addition, unlike the AS/400 or iSeries, the PC or NT server's password is case sensitive and you must be careful to match all cases used in both the user ID and password:

```
RUNRMTCMD +  
  CMD(c:\temp\mybatch.bat) +  
  RMTLOCNAME(MyPCName *IP) +  
  RMTUSER('myUSER') +  
  RMTPWD('myPASS')
```

### Points to Note:

- If the CMD parameter contains blanks then it should be enclosed in single quotation marks.
- The MyPCName should exist as an entry in the TCP/IP Hosts Table.
- The PC's IP address can be used in place of the PC Name. In this case it should be enclosed in single quotation marks.
